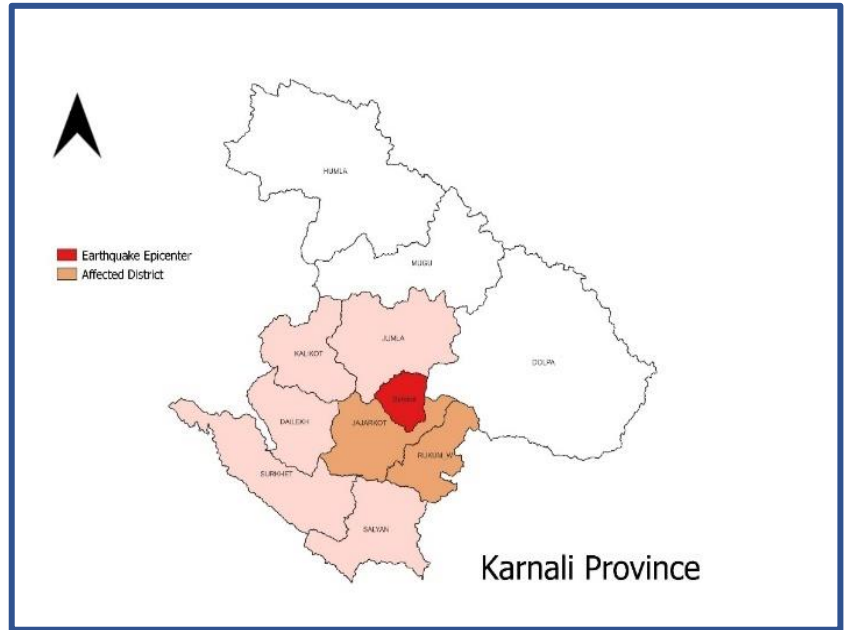



Handover program of Medical Camp Kit at Nalgad Municipality, Limsa Jajarkot

Situation Overview

On the night of November 3, 2023, a 6.4 magnitude earthquake struck the Jajarkot and Rukum West district of Karnali Province with its epicenter located in Ramidanda, Jajarkot district, at 11:47 PM. Following the initial earthquake, numerous aftershocks occurred, causing fear among the local population. The ongoing aftershocks have compelled residents to evacuate their homes and seek to stay in open areas. A total of 18 local governments are affected where Jajarkot and Rukum West are severely affected in terms of human casualties, and damage to houses in Karnali Province.

Health & Nutrition Cluster Decision made through PHSD meeting on 2080-10-03 at 10:30 AM

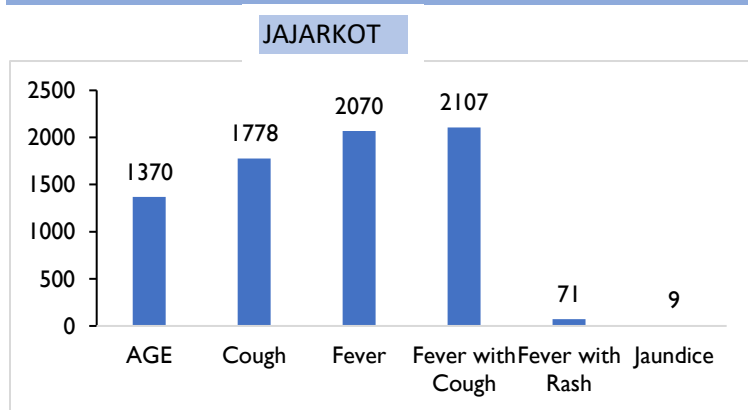
After the earthquake, the monitoring, evaluation and supervision that will be conducted in Jajarkot, Rukum West and other districts at different times, the employees who go for this either from health service directorate or the employees who go for the monitoring from various partner organizations will be made to monitor in a unified manner and decision has been made to inform about the task to the respective local level, respective district health service office, health service directorate and Ministry of Social Development.

Previously, the 4W Formats sent to various organizations working in the health sector and some of the organizations have not completed yet, so it was decided to complete and send the 4W Format to all government and partner organizations.

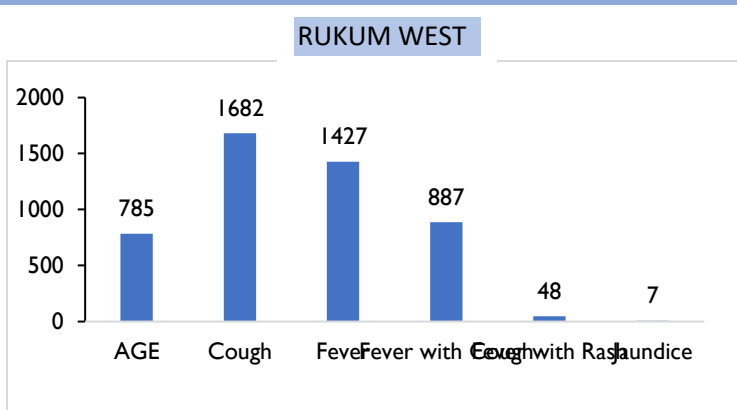
It was decided to complete the report by sending the update of the sub-clusters which are created earlier to PHEOC Surkhet in accordance with their respective responsibilities.

Sub cluster	Key Activities Performed
Mental Health and NCDs	Provided primary psychosocial support to postpartum women by health workers with primary psychosocial training at Barekot-2 Rokaya Gaau.
	Conducted awareness sessions on mental health during earthquake in community group at Sanibheri Rural Municipality-8, Fukru.
Disease Surveillance & Control	Active Syndromic Surveillance is continuously being carried out by the WHO in coordination with the health coordinators of local governments in Jajarkot (Kushe, Nalgad, Bheri, Barekot, Junichande, Chedagad, Shivalaya) and Rukum West (Athabiskot, Chaurjahari, Sanibheri).
	5 surveillance officers from WHO have been mobilized to the earthquake affected local governments of Jajarkot and Rukum West district for supporting syndromic surveillance.
Child Health	Completed Measles, Rubella and Typhoid vaccination campaign in Rukum west and Jajarkot District.
	Routine immunization service continues.
	Baby packages and winterization kit for children were distributed in Bheri municipality, Kushe Rural Municipality and Sanibheri rural municipality.
	Family tents were distributed for pregnant, lactating women and children under two years of age in Sanibheri Rural municipality, Aathbiskot Municipality, Nalgad Municipality, Bheri Municipality and Kushe RM.
	Covid -19 vaccination review on Rukum west and Jajarkot District.

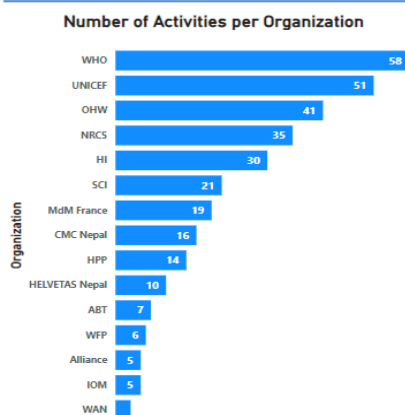
TOTAL SYMPTOMS REPORTED AT JAJARKOT FROM 5TH NOV 2023 TO 16TH JAN 2024



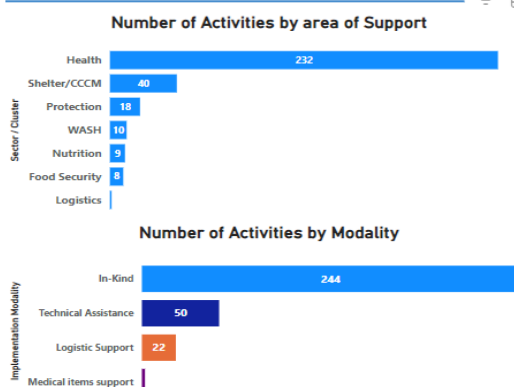
TOTAL SYMPTOMS REPORTED AT RUKUM WEST FROM 5TH NOV 2023 TO 16TH JAN 2024
