

The first tremors of the earthquake were recorded on **3-Nov-2023 (17-kartik-2080)**

- Total cases in Rukum: 240/ Referred: 25 (6 in Trauma Kathmandu, one Surkhet, and others in Bheri Hospital Nepalgunj) 166 cases discharged and 53 mortalities
- Barekot Basic Hospital has been destroyed: The emergency room and Birthing center walls have collapsed.
- 26 patients were referred to Bheri Hospital Nepalgung from Jajarkot and Rukum, one brought dead
- 46 were brought to Rukum District Hospital, and 11 were referred to a higher center,
 Bheri Hospital Nepalgunj
- 26 brought to Province Hospital Surkhet
- 22 brought to Chaujhari Hospital
- Getma Health post, one old building has collapsed but hospital services have been fully functioning as the new building is available.

Activities Done

- Including 1 team for Atbish is mobilized from Rukum West
- Ambulances have been sent to Surkhet Airport for rescue by a medical doctor
- Information Hub from PHEOC Mr. Nawa Raj Kande, Mr. Bhanu Bhakta Bashyal, and Dr. Bhoj Ram Bam
- Control room established in the leadership of Krishna Kahatr 9858026341 including three persons - Jajarkot and Rukum West
- Help Desk in Bheri Ganga Municipality -
- HW team to be sent to District Hospital and that team to be deployed to affected Hospitals/HFs
- SIMTA HW team is ready to move to Jajarkot as required
- A Red Cross ambulance is mobilized and 150 sets of utensils, 300 Blankets, and 300 sets
 of tarpaulin are sent to Rukum, and an estimated 2000 HH has been damaged. Based on
 loss and injury required materials are managed and coordinated with another supporting
 agency.
- Food items are required in Hospital patients and their caretakers
- UNICEF sending logistic items (food and nonfood) to Jajarkot and Rukum West including 100 neonatal incentive kits and 2 medical tents
- Atbiskot and Sani Bheri are highly affected in Rukum West
- INF is sending food items and Blankets for Jajarkot
- EMT From Central has been mobilized to the affected area.

- Similarly, a Team from the Lumbini Province has also been deployed to the affected areas.
- Save the Children is working closely with the local government of affected areas and has dispatched a response team and relief materials for 200 households based on the preliminary data of the loss and damage. The current dispatch items are 500 hygene kit and 400 hight Altitude Shelter Kit.
- Handicap International is going to deliver assistive devices and mobility aids along with rehabilitation professionals tomorrow. The items to be delivered as below: Basic Shelter Kit: 200, Axiliray Crutches: 22pair, Elbow crutches: 20, Wheelchair: 36, Walker: 58, and walking stick: 200
- CARE Nepal is working closely with the local government on assessment including rapid gender assessment. The local implementing partner is HRDC in Jajarkot and support is being provided to 200 households, which includes Shelter kit 250 sets, Blankets- 400, Dignity kits- 40, and kitchen utensils sets: 200.
- Ambulance Dispatchers have been mobilized; 6 ambulances are on standby in Airport
- A Province mobile Rapid Response team of 8 paramedics with rescue materials and medicine has been deployed from MOSD and HSD to the affected area through a road connection and will be looking around the local municipalities of the affected area.

Activation of Provincial Incident Command System / Decisions of the meetings

- Prepare details of doctors and health workers from various hospitals (within the province) who can be deployed immediately and deploy them as needed.
- Request to immediately prepare and send the required and necessary medicines and materials from Jajarkot.
- Under the leadership of Sr. Health Education Officer Mr. Nava Rraj Kandel, Public Health Administrator Mr. Bhanu Bhakta Basyal, and Dr. Bhojraj Bam to deploy twenty-four hours.
- As ambulances and vehicles have to be arranged for the transport of the injured, it was decided to arrange for ambulances and some vehicles in case of incapacity and deploy them to the necessary places.

2nd Phase Health Cluster decision Done through HSD Meeting at 11: 30 PM

- To Update the details of health workers and the number of health institutions registered in the municipality.
- Coordinating through PHEOC to manage the referral system.
- To update the statistics of Reproductive Health cluster-wise affected pregnant women and newborns and manage them as necessary.

• To conduct meetings with all the stakeholders for every 3/3 hours to update the situation.

3rd Phase Health Cluster Decision Done through HSD Meeting at 3: 00 PM

- It was decided to request the district to send a report in the prescribed format.
- Discussed about health workers and medical equipment that went to the district.
- To Send 200 vials of TT vaccine to Jajarkot and 100 vials to Rukum West including AEFI Kit.
