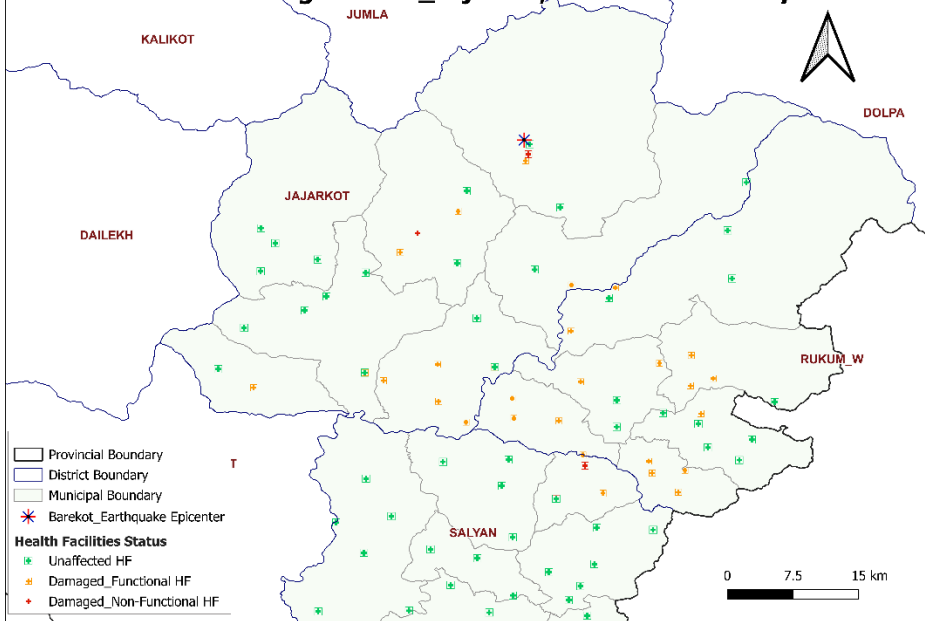

Situation Overview

The National Earthquake Monitoring and Research Center (NEMRC), a division of the Department of Mines and Geology (DMG), has documented a series of seismic events with epicenters located in the vicinity of Jajarkot District, which is situated within Karnali Province. The initial seismic activity associated with this earthquake was initially detected on November 3, 2023 (17-Kartik-2080). A total of 26,557 HHs are fully damaged while 35,455 partially damaged. (NDRRMA, 9 Nov 2023)

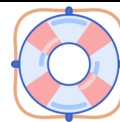

Major Activities Update :

- Provincial Incident Command system activated on 18th Kartik, 2080 at 6:00 am. One door policy was applied
- Health and Nutrition cluster meeting conduction every day. A total of 10 cluster meeting has been conducted till date.
- Health worker mapping was done and several teams of doctors and paramedics were deployed in the affected areas from within and outside the province. Delivery of necessary rescue and relief materials ongoing.
- Team formation and deployment to affected areas consisting of staffs from PHSD and external development partners for situation assessment, health promotion and preventive activities, providing psychosocial counselling, and identifying gaps and challenges.
- Mapping of health facilities damaged by the earthquake and identification of functional and non-functional and types of services being provided through affected HFs.
- Inter cluster coordination meeting with MoHP, EDCD, FWD, Curative Division and other stakeholders. The decisions were made to focus on WASH, Nutrition, MHPSS and vaccination.
- An emergency rehabilitation committee formed to manage the disability caused by the earthquake and decision was made to store the necessary auxiliary materials needed for the rehabilitation of the people affected.
- Mobilization of additional workforce consisting of 4 members in the affected Palikas, representing Health Service Directorate, Karnali on 24th Kartik, 2028. The team will carry out Wash Surveillance, Disease Surveillance, Syndromic management, First aid and Medicine distribution and management for Barekot RM, Aathbiskot Municipality and Darma Rural Municipality.

- Meeting with WASH cluster and decision made to speed up water quality testing and setting up of temporary latrine/ construction of toilets and distribution of health kits.
- Coordination meeting with Provincial Planning Commission and stakeholders of Multi Sector Nutrition Program to ensure food safety and nutrition of the affected community

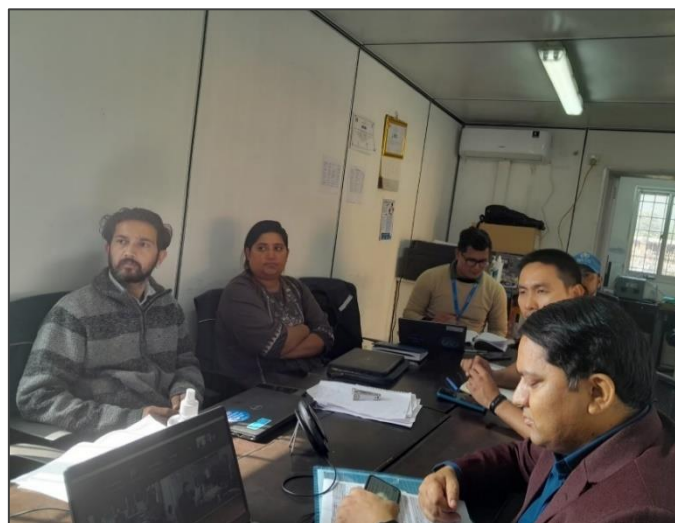

Health & Nutrition Cluster Decision made through PHSD Meeting on 2080-7-24 at 10:00 AM	
1.	It was agreed to assemble groups of staff available from the Directorate of Health Services and several partner organizations to provide services throughout the approaching Tihar holiday season.
2.	Under the direction of Health Service Directorate, it was determined to retain the Back-up Team ready to be dispatched to affected areas as needed.
3.	It was decided that over the holidays, all staff of Health Service Directorate would be mobilized based on demand and would remain ready.
4.	It was decided to nominate the following individuals as Focal Points on behalf of Health Service Directorate for coordination with the WASH CLUSTER as well as related response and management:
5.	It was decided that the following partner organizations in addition to Ministry of Social Development, Directorate of Health Services, Provincial Health Supply Management Center, Public Health Service Office, Surkhet will have necessary workforce as well as vehicles on stand-by for the delivery of various health and WASH kits. <i>WHO, UNICEF, WFP, UNDP, SSBH, Save the Children, OHW, USAID-ARH, NRCS, Handicapped International, Plan Nepal, Water Aid, TPO, CMC Nepal, INF</i>
6.	It was decided to discuss the situation update, issues and challenges in the community with all the teams previously deployed in the affected areas on 10/11/2023 at 5 pm in the meeting hall of Health Service Directorate.

Activation of Provincial Incident Command System/Decisions of the meetings on 2080-7-18 (6:00 AM)	
1.	Mapping of Human Resources (Medical and Paramedics) was done and deployed.
2.	Need assessment and gaps identification to be done and request to province from earthquake affected districts.
3.	Under the leadership of Sr. Health Education Officer Mr. Nava Raj Kandel, Public Health Administrator Mr. Bhanu Bhakta Bashyal, and Dr. Bhoj Raj Bam, PHEOC to be deployed for Information Management and dissemination from PHEOC.
4.	Arrangement of ambulances and vehicles management as per need in coordination with earthquake affected districts to be managed by Province and districts
